NEWS ! Hot Line for Wildlife.

Redlands Council recently invited "Animal Carers, Wild Life Rescuers, including Pelican & Seabird Rescue and other Voluntary organisations to a meeting at Indigiscapes (On a night of monsoon type rain where we all got wet in the arranged bushland site!)

The aim of the meeting was to clarify the response arrangements for injured wildlife.

The RSPCA advised that its HOTLINE for WILDLIFE RESCUE is 07 3426-9999 or 1300 264 625 (1300 ANIMAL)

This will provide improved response and care.

D.E.R.M. (Dept of Environment & Resource Management) advised that their HOTLINE is 1300-130-372 However, DERM will now only respond on their new updated Hotline to Marine wildlife rescue

This will apply to turtle, dugongs, dolphins and other marine wildlife.

NOTE: "Baywatch" is advised the Brisbane City Council will now provide an "Emergency Wildlife Ambulance and referral service" to Wildlife Carers. The public can call on the well known phone number 07 3403-8888
