## Membership Overview

PaSR has eight categories of membership, these are:

1. Principal	Responsible for co-ordination of all rescues, rehabilitation, promotion, education & training. Authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit.
2. Partner	Responsible for assisting the Principals with their duties. Authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit.
3. Participant	Can provide assistance with rescues and rehabilitation under supervision of a Partner or Principal. Not authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit. Endorsement to Partner upon successful completion of PaSR training.
4. Person	Initial membership status. Can provide assistance with rescues and rehabilitation under supervision of a Partner or Principal. Not authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit. Endorsement to Participant upon successful completion of PaSR training.
5. Prep	A junior member, 18 years and under. Not authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit.
6. Parton	Invited by PaSR Management Committee. Not authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit.
7. Perpetual	Life member as elected by a majority vote of PaSR members.
8. Provider	Invited by PaSR Management Committee. Not authorised to operate using the PaSR Ecoaccess Permit.
