## **Pelican and Seabird Rescue Inc .**

Baywatch recently accepted an invitation to visit the Pelican and Sea Bird Wild life Refuge and Rehabilitation facility, a property of 2.8 acres up at Beerwah, set in the beautiful area of the hinterland near the Glasshouse Mountains. Travel was by a special "wild life rescue ambulance" vehicle provided by the Pelican & Seabird Rescue team at the Sunshine Coast. We were accompanied by two important patients, two rather large injured pelicans, which had been carefully loaded into the specially designed separate wild life compartment on the vehicle.

The property is a major conservation area on the east coast designed for the treatment, care and rehabilitation of injured, sick and orphaned seabirds and native water birds. Following treatment these birds are then released back into the habitat where they were originally found.
