The group developed a network of members and a range of partnerships even prior to their incorporation. They have members in many of Brisbane's suburbs, North Stradbroke and other bay islands, the Sunshine Coast and the Gold Coast. Partnerships have been formed with the Environment Protection Agency (EPA) various vets and wildlife organisations, Port of Brisbane Corporation and many more people and organisations. They are now incorporated with a constitution and are registered with the E.P.A. and the Federal Government's Department of Environment, Water and Heritage as an animal care organisation.

Information on all birds rescued and treated is recorded thoroughly in a similar way to humans in our hospital system. This information is then provided to the E.P.A.
